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DOPAMINE DEFICITS AS AN ADDICTION PHENOTYPE

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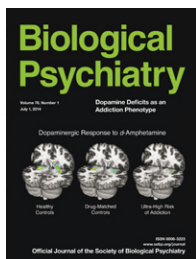
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The image on the cover highlights work presented in Casey *et al.* (in this issue, pages 23–30). The authors assessed the dopamine response during an amphetamine challenge and report that subjects with a family history of substance use disorders, compared with stimulant drug-naïve and drug-matched healthy control groups, exhibited a decreased response, particularly within the right ventral striatum.
