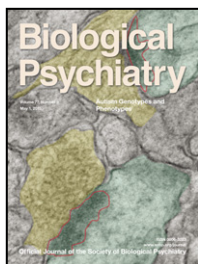

Aceti *et al.* observed an enlarged postsynaptic density area (red outline) from dendritic spines contacted by presynaptic terminals (yellow) in *Syngap1* mutant mice, as highlighted by the electron microscopy image on the cover (in this issue, pages 805–815; see Figure 5). In this work, they found that *Syngap1* mutations, which are associated with developmental brain disorders, disrupt critical periods of dendritic growth and spine plasticity.



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
