The authors have recognized an error in their paper. Specifically, the labels for Limbic A and Limbic B were mistakenly reversed. This error affects the labeling in Figure 1C, Figure 2C,

and Figure 4A, where the colors for Limbic A and Limbic B should be reversed. This error also affects the legend text in Figure S2, where reference to Limbic A and Limbic B should have been to Limbic B and Limbic A, respectively. This error does not impact the conclusions of the study.

DSST.” In full, the corrected sentence reads: “In collaboration with Adams Clinical, participants with major depressive disorder (MDD) underwent both digital and paper-pencil versions of the DSST offering a unique opportunity to inform usability, as well as compare and validate the smart phone delivered DSST; Cognition Kit DSST.” The abstract has been corrected.
