Author Checklist for COMMENTARIES

This optional checklist is intended to help authors efficiently submit Commentaries to *Biological Psychiatry* and should not be uploaded with the submission. Full details regarding all *Biological Psychiatry* guidelines are available in the [Guide for Authors](#). Submissions that do not adhere to these guidelines will be returned for correction and delay processing.

PRIOR TO SUBMISSION

- All authors, if more than one, have read and approved the most recent version of the manuscript
- All authors have provided their complete financial disclosures and conflicts of interest
- Secure permission to reproduce previously-published material, if applicable
- Gather the following:
 - Valid email addresses for all authors; institutional email addresses are strongly preferred
 - All submission files (manuscript, figure/table)
 - ☆ *Helpful Hint: Commentaries are limited to the 1500 word maximum of the main text and a single figure or table; supplemental files are not permitted*

MANUSCRIPT CONTENT

- Does not exceed the 1500 word maximum for Commentaries
- The manuscript includes the following general sections: title page, main text, acknowledgments, disclosures, references, figure/table legend
- Title Page is present as the first page of the manuscript and includes:
 - Title of commentary
 - ☆ *Helpful Hint: A 'real' title is required; "Commentary on..." is not an acceptable article title*
 - List of authors (in order) with full names and all affiliations
 - Corresponding author notation and his/her contact information (email address)
- No abstract is included
- Pages are numbered
- Text is double spaced
- Acknowledgments section is included, with sources of grant and other material/financial support
- Financial disclosures/conflicts section is present and includes the required information for every author; if an author has nothing to declare, this must be explicitly stated
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 - Limited to a maximum of 10 (no exceptions)
 - The article being commented upon is included as one of the 10 references
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FILES & FILE TYPES

- Manuscript: must be provided as a Word file; PDF and LaTeX files are not accepted
- Figure: uploaded separately in one of the following formats: TIFF, PDF, PPT, EPS
 - The figure title/legend is in the manuscript file and not included in the image file
 - Panels are labeled with capital letters (A, B, C), if applicable
 - The figure is a single image (two panels may not be in separate files)
- Table: must be supplied in an editable format (Word or Excel), either at the end of the manuscript file or in a separate file

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
